U21 Football Championship

Aghabullogue were drawn in Group 4 of the **U21 Football Championship** and were drawn against Inniscarra, Blarney and Clondrohid, however Clondrohid were unable to field and Aghabullogue only had two remaining opponents in the group. Aghabullogue played Inniscarra first and were very unfortunate to lose after a close game in very poor weather conditions. Aghabullogue lead for the majority of the game, however aided by a strong wind in the second half, Inniscarra got the upper hand and ran out winners in the end on a scoreline of 3-06 to 2-07. Aghabullogue then played Blarney in Coachford on March, 1st and recorded a very impressive victory on a scoreline of 2-11 to 0-13 points. These results ensured a 1/4 final spot in the B Championship, where Aghabullogue played Kilmurry. Aghabullogue put on a top class performance on the day and despite being a close game, Aghabullogue came out the stronger and recorded an impressive and deserved victory with the scoreboard reading 2-13 to 2-12. Next up was Macroom in the **Semi Final**, this game was played in Carrigadrohid on Saturday, 22nd March, however luck was not on our side and multiple injuries meant Aghabullogue's chances were lessened. Despite the best efforts of the Aghabullogue lads, Macroom came out on top on a scoreline of 0-16 to 1-08, which meant they qualified for the U21 B Football Final against Inniscarra.

Camogie Update

- **Senior B Camogie:** The Senior Camogie ladies have already played two out of their four league games. The girls were unfortunate to lose to Kilbrittan and drew against Fr O'Neills. The girls must still play Clonakilty and Eire Og. Draws for Championship are yet to take place.
- **U18 Camogie:** The U18 Camogie girls got the year off to a great start with impressive wins over Sliabh Rua, Ballinhasig and Newtownshandrum in their league campaign. These victories ensured the girls a place in the Semi Final of the league against Brian Dillons. The Semi Final was played on Wednesday, 16th April in Brian Dillons and our girls were very unfortunate to lose by the narrowest of margins. At half time the sides were on level terms, however in the second half Brian Dillons managed to get on top and won on a score line of 0-06 to 0-05. The girls can be very proud of their performances to date and have the Championship campaign to look forward to.
- **U16 Camogie:** The first outing for the U16 Camogie girls in the league is scheduled for Wednesday, 23rd April when they travel to Killeagh. The girls must also play Brian Dillons, Ballincollig and Ballyhea/Milford.
- **U14 Camogie:** The U14 girls got off to a great start in their league campaign when they beat Courcey Rovers on Sunday, 13th April on a score line of 4-06 to 2-01. The girls must now play Sarsfields, St. Finbarr's, Blarney, Inniscarra and Millstreet in their remaining league games.
